



Edging

Established lawns tend to grow over onto the sidewalk and driveways as the growing season progresses, and even creep into flowerbeds or garden areas. Edging your lawn areas resets the definition in the landscape and provides a smooth, attractive transition between your grass, flowerbeds, sidewalks and driveways. This service is charged by the linear foot, so getting an estimate is as simple as measuring the distance around the area and calling for an estimate.

Scheduling...

- Edging is usually done in the spring and fall, but can be done anytime. Book this service at your convenience, when you notice the grass starting to grow over onto the sidewalk or other areas where it shouldn't be.

What we do...

- We use a power edger to get the straight, clean finish along sidewalks, driveways and concrete edging
- The power edger also works well with grass to garden areas if there is no plastic edging between
- Areas that the power edger can't be used, we do with an edging tool
- All trimmed sod and related debris are removed and disposed of
- Sidewalks and driveways are swept or blown off
